Britten Sinfonia in Norwich Wednesday 4th July 12.30-3pm

Musicians from the internationally acclaimed Britten Sinfonia will be performing a series of free, short recitals at five historic locations in the centre of Norwich to celebrate the arrival of the Olympic Torch.

Come and join them for the celebrations - drop into one or two, or walk from venue to venue to catch all five. **FREE admission to all performances**

Join ensembles of musicians from Britten Sinfonia as they play a range of music, including a piece by Norfolk-based composer Jane Wells specially commissioned to celebrate the Olympic Torch Relay in Norwich.

Five historic locations in the city centre have been chosen to host special performances to add to the atmosphere of this important day.

1pm, 2pm, 3pm Country & Eastern (Old Skating Rink Gallery) - Violin & Tabla

1.30pm, 3pm The Assembly Rooms - String Quartet

2pm Strangers' Hall Museum - Brass Duo



Between 12.30 and 3pm on 4th July, different ensembles will give short recitals in venues just a few minutes' walk from each other in the centre of Norwich.

If you wish to attend all five recitals try 12.30pm Guildhall, 1pm Country & Eastern, 2pm Strangers Hall, 2.30pm St Peter Mancroft and 3pm Assembly Rooms

Recitals last up to 25 minutes and there is **FREE admission to all performances.**
